## *Turtle Observer Training*

**SATURDAY, MARCH 13, 2010, 9 A.M. TO 2 P.M.**

Become a trained turtle observer and learn to monitor and record behavior of the native Western Pond Turtle around Lagunitas, Bon Tempe and Alpine Lakes. The required orientation includes a hike around Lake Lagunitas, a discussion on turtle biology and methods for engaging the public. Volunteers will schedule one-hour visits from March through May. Volunteers can be as young as 8 if accompanied by an adult. Rain will not cancel the orientation but may require rescheduling of the hike. We will meet at Sky Oaks Headquarters in Fairfax at 9 a.m.
