

Reminder: Outdoor Water Use Regulations

As a reminder, all outdoor water use regulations remain in effect. Drought or no drought, these common-sense practices are simple ways to save water outdoors.

Prohibited Water Uses

- ◆ Irrigating ornamental landscape areas or turf grass areas with potable water more than three days per week
- ◆ Irrigating during or within 48 hours after measurable rainfall
- ◆ Irrigating between 9 a.m. – 7 p.m., except for system testing and repair
- ◆ Using a hose without a shutoff nozzle
- ◆ Allowing irrigation water to runoff or overspray the irrigated area
- ◆ Hosing down sidewalks, driveways, and other hard-surfaced areas
- ◆ Non-recirculating decorative fountains
