MMWD's Service Charge Waiver Program is for customers with a gross household income at or below 80% of the Marin County low income level set by the Federal Department of Housing & Urban Development (FDHUD). Under this program the bimonthly meter service charge and watershed management fee are waived, so customers pay only for water used.

Gross household income is defined as all revenues, from all household members, from whatever source derived, whether taxable or non-taxable, including but not limited to: wages, salaries, interest, dividends, spousal support and child support payments, public assistance payments, social security and pensions, rental income, income from self-employment, and all employment-related, non-cash income.

Please note: Low income guidelines are subject to change periodically.
